Fri.: The Dedication of the Lateran Basilica


Sat.: Saint Leo the Great, Pope and Doctor of the Church



Catholic Ministries Appeal Update

Although we were happy to reach and surpass our established goal, we would indeed be happier if a higher number of parishioners had made a contribution of any amount. In 2017, 79 parishioners made donations to the Appeal. This year our total has remained at 74 for months. This number is roughly half of the number of individuals/ families who are registered as envelope users at this parish. (Remember that the use of our envelopes is required for you to be considered as *registered* here. In addition, statements of yearly contributions to St. Ladislaus Church can only be provided to those who use the envelopes for their contributions.) Know that it is not too late to make a contribution of any amount. Many of us, because of work or family commitments, cannot offer hands-on help to the sick, the disabled, the poor. We might wish that we had the time to sit at the bedside of the hospitalized or pass on our Catholic faith to children in religious education classes. Our monetary gifts, no matter how small, enable the hands of those who perform these and many other important services. We the donors become, in effect, *surrogate angels*.
