



SUNDAY REFLECTION

Today, we encounter situations similar to those described in this Gospel passage. If God were to ask us right now, "Who do people say that I am?" (Mark 8:27), we would have to report all kinds of responses, some even quite strange. A quick look at what is being aired in various media would give us a clear picture. Yet... more than twenty centuries of 'Church time' have passed. After all these years, we grieve and, like Saint Faustina, we complain to Jesus: 'Why is the number of those who know You still so small?'

On that occasion, when Simon Peter made his confession of faith, Jesus "warned them not to tell anyone about him" (Mark 8:30). His messianic identity had to be revealed to the Jewish people progressively. Later, the climactic moment would come when Jesus Christ would declare—once and for all—that He was the Messiah: "I am" (Luke 22:70). Since then, there is no excuse for not declaring or acknowledging Him as the Son of God, who came into the world for our salvation. Even more so, all baptized Christians have the joyful 'priestly' duty to preach the Gospel to all nations and to all creatures (cf. Mark 16:15). This call to proclaim the Good News is all the more urgent when we consider that all sorts of mistaken, even blasphemous, opinions are still being spread about Him.

However, the proclamation of His messiahship and the coming of His Kingdom must pass through the Cross. Indeed, Jesus Christ "began to teach them that the Son of Man must suffer greatly" (Mark 8:31), and the Catechism reminds us that 'the Church progresses on her pilgrimage amidst the persecutions of the world and the consolations of God' (n. 769). This is the path to follow Christ and to make Him known: "Whoever wishes to come after me... take up his cross, and follow me" (Mark 8:34).

CATECHISM *of the* CATHOLIC CHURCH

What does it mean to say that God is truth?

"God is light and in him is no darkness" (1 Jn 1:5). His Word is truth (Prov 8:7; 2 Sam 7:28), and his Law is truth (Ps 119:142). Jesus himself vouches for God's truth by declaring before Pilate, "For this I was born, and for this I have come into the world, to bear witness to the truth" (Jn 18:37). [214-217] The truth of God cannot be "proved" or subjected to empirical tests, since science cannot make him an object of investigation. And yet God subjects himself to a special sort of proof. We know that God is truth on the basis of the absolute credibility of Jesus. He is "the way, and the truth, and the life" (Jn 14:6). Anyone who enters into a relationship with him can find this out by putting it to the test. If God were not "true", then faith and reason could not have a dialogue with each other. An agreement is possible, however, because God is truth, and the truth is divine.

KATECHIZM KOŚCIOŁA KATOLICKIEGO

Dlaczego Bóg nazywa siebie?

Bóg nazywa siebie, ponieważ chciałby, aby zwracano się do Niego po imieniu. [203-213, 230-231] Bóg nie chciałby pozostać nierozpoznany. Nie chce być czczony jako „wyższa istota” jedynie odczuwana albo intuicyjnie przeczowana. Bóg chciałby być znany i przywoływany jako ktoś rzeczywisty i działający. W płonącej krzewie Bóg wyjawia Mojżeszowi swoje święte imię -> JHWH (Wj 3, 14). Bóg pozwala swojemu ludowi zwracać się do siebie, pozostaje jednakże Bogiem ukrytym, istniejącą tajemnicą. Z głębokiego szacunku wobec Boga w Izraelu nie wymawiano (i nie wymawia się) imienia Bożego i zastępuje się je zwrotem Adonaj (Panie). Również tym tytułem posługuje się -> NOWY TESTAMENT, kiedy uwielbia Jezusa jako prawdziwego Boga: „Jezus jest Panem!”

ROZWAŻANIE NA NIEDZIELĘ

Dzisiaj, znajdujemy się w sytuacji bardzo podobnej do opisanej w perykopie ewangelicznej. Gdyby teraz Bóg zapytał nas «za kogo uważają mnie ludzie?» (Mk 8,27), musielibyśmy mu przytoczyć różne odpowiedzi, nawet te najbardziej barwne. Wystarczy rozejrzeć się po tym co unosi się i czym się oddycha w różnorodnych mediach. Tyłko, że... upłynęło więcej niż dwadzieścia wieków “czasu Kościoła”. Po tylu latach wciąż ubolewamy i, wraz ze Świętą Faustyną, skarżymy się przed Jezusem: «Dlaczego tak tak niewielu Cię poznało?».

Wówczas Jezus wobec wyznania wiary przez Piotra «surowo im przykazał, aby nikomu o Nim nie mówili» (Mk 8,30). Jego mesjańskie posłannictwo miało być przekazywane ludowi stopniowo. Dopiero później nastąpił szczyt, kiedy Jezus Chrystus raz na zawsze ogłosił, że jest Mesjaszem: «Ja jestem» (Łk 22,70). Od tamtej pory nie ma usprawiedliwienia przed tym, by nie głosić i nie wyzawać w Nim Syna Bożego, który przyszedł na świat dla naszego zbawienia. A nawet więcej: my wszyscy wierzący mamy “kapłańską” powinność głoszenia Ewangelii wszelkiemu stworzeniu (cf. Mk 16,15). Wezwanie do głoszenia Dobrej Nowiny jest tak samo pilne teraz, kiedy o Jego Osobie głosi się różne opinie fałszywe, a nawet błędne.

Głoszenie jego mesjaństwa i przyjścia Jego Królestwa przechodzi przez Krzyż. W rzeczywistości Jezus Chrystus «Syn Człowieczy musi wiele cierpieć» (Mk 8,31), a Katechizm przypomina nam, że «Kościół kontuuje swoją pielgrzymkę wśród prześladowań świata i pocieszeń Boga.» (n. 769). To właśnie jest droga naśladowania Chrystusa i pokazywania go innym: «Jeśli kto chce pójść za Mną (...) niech weźmie swój krzyż i niech Mnie naśladowuje» (Mk 8,34).

COMUNIDAD HISPANO

REFLEXIÓN PARA EL DOMINGO



Hoy, oy día nos encontramos con situaciones similares a la descrita en este pasaje evangélico. Si, ahora mismo, Dios nos preguntara «¿quién dicen los hombres que soy yo?» (Mc 8,27), tendríamos que informarle acerca de todo tipo de respuestas, incluso pintorescas. Bastaría con echar una ojeada a lo que se ventila y airea en los más variados medios de comunicación. Sólo que... ya han pasado más de veinte siglos de “tiempo de la Iglesia”. Después de tantos años, nos dolemos y —con santa Faustina— nos quejamos ante Jesús: «¿Por qué es tan pequeño el número de los que Te conocen?».

Jesús, en aquella ocasión de la confesión de fe hecha por Simón Pedro, «les mandó enérgicamente que a nadie hablaran acerca de Él» (Mc 8,30). Su condición mesiánica debía ser transmitida al pueblo judío con una pedagogía progresiva. Más tarde llegaría el momento cumbre en que Jesucristo declararía —de una vez para siempre— que Él era el Mesías: «Yo soy» (Lc 22,70). Desde entonces, ya no hay excusa para no declararle ni reconocerle como el Hijo de Dios venido al mundo por nuestra salvación. Más aun: todos los bautizados tenemos ese gozoso deber “sacerdotal” de predicar el Evangelio por todo el mundo y a toda criatura (cf. Mc 16,15). Esta llamada a la predicación de la Buena Nueva es tanto más urgente si tenemos en cuenta que acerca de Él se siguen profiriendo todo tipo de opiniones equivocadas, incluso blasfemas.

Pero el anuncio de su mesianidad y del advenimiento de su Reino pasa por la Cruz. En efecto, Jesucristo «comenzó a enseñarles que el Hijo del hombre debía sufrir mucho» (Mc 8,31), y el Catecismo nos recuerda que «la Iglesia avanza en su peregrinación a través de las persecuciones del mundo y de los consuelos de Dios» (n. 769). He aquí, pues, el camino para seguir a Cristo y darlo a conocer: «Si alguno quiere venir en pos de mí (...) tome su cruz y sígame» (Mc 8,34).

Liturgical Minister Training- Fall 2024

The Diocese of Rockville Center will offer training for those who wish to serve as Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion and Lectors. No walk-ins permitted, all participants must be registered in advance with a letter from their pastor.

Extraordinary Minister of Holy Communion: Part A - This training is required for all those who are beginning as Ministers. This "BASIC" training is required for all Extraordinary Ministers of Holy Communion. Those who wish to minister in hospitals, nursing homes and to the homebound are required to attend Part B training in addition to BASIC training. One must attend Part A training prior to Part B training.

A **Lector Workshop** is available for both new and experienced lectors.

You may not take EMHC Part A and the Lector Workshop on the same day.
